APACE Washington is looking for an energetic, passionate individual to help us empower a unified AAPI political voice. We need a seasonal organizer to support our field efforts to turn out voters and make democracy accessible to our communities during the 2021 election season. Project will be based outside of Seattle in one of APACE's areas of impact. From September to November, 2021, the selected candidate will help us call, text and knock on doors in one of the areas we are working in for this cycle. Canvassing experience is required, this is an independent contractor position that will be responsible for managing their projects from start to finish. This position is a mixed virtual and in-person position based in South King County. Ability to work in person in the project city required.

What you bring:

- Excellent people skills — comfortable speaking on the phone or in person with strangers, especially non-native English speakers
- Passion for civic engagement, community, and/or racial equity
- Flexibility, creativity, and quick thinking in the field
- Able to walk or stand for up to five hours and sit for up to three
- Bilingual Hindi, Vietnamese, Tagalog, or Korean skills are a plus!
- Ability to work well on independent projects
- Strong interpersonal skills, able to give and receive feedback
- Canvassing, organizing, and/or campaign experience required
- Experience using VAN and ThruText is preferred
